

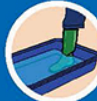
# Poultry Farm Biosecurity

## KEEP A RECORD



Visitors, maintenance vehicles, feed/litter delivery, cleaning and disinfecting

## SHED TO SHED ACCESS



Provide foot bath and boot change at every entry and exit point

Litter/bedding storage in an adapted bio-secure area to maintain the pathogen-free status

## USED LITTER



Dispose of used litter according to local legislation but at least 3.2 km (2 miles) away from the farm

## VEHICLES



Vehicles must be cleaned and disinfected prior to entering the farm facility



DO NOT allow unauthorized vehicles on the farm



Make sure all feed deliveries stay outside of the fence



Disposable shoe covers to be worn between car and entry to shower facilities or supply disinfectant spray to spray shoes before entry

## INTERIOR



Easy to clean and disinfect concrete floor



Easy to clean and disinfect equipment



Ensure good quality water is available

## VISITORS



Restrict visitors



Provide shower facilities



Provide change of clothes and boots

## EQUIPMENT



Phones, cameras, laptops etc- Do not bring onto the farm unless absolutely necessary, all equipment brought onto the farm must go through a working disinfection cabinet



Avoid moving equipment between farms. If unavoidable, ensure equipment is cleaned, disinfected, and swabbed before moving

## ANIMAL & PEST CONTROL



Keep other livestock away from the facility



Establish a baiting program for rodents and insects, prevent access of wild birds according to local regulations
